## **God's Word Never Changes**

**Numbers 23:19 (KJV)**

**God is not a man, that He should lie; neither the son of man,  
that He should repent: hath He said, and shall He not do it?  
Or hath He spoken, and shall He not make it good?**

**Balak, the King of Moab, sought Balaam out to curse Israel. This verse comes in the midst of His second prophecy to bless Israel and not curse them.**

**Balak thought that God would change His mind if he persisted in trying to curse Israel. God was determined not to curse, but to bless Israel. It is in the context of this story that God lets Balak know that His Word will go unchanged. Balak thought that if Balaam would look at things from a different vantage point that God would change His mind.**

**So it is with us. God is not going to change His Word. At times, I know we can't believe what God says to us, but we need to accept that He has not lied. God is not going to change His mind on what He has said. God means every word that is in the Bible.**

**Here is one way to express faith. Faith is expecting God to do what you know He has said in His Word that He will do. Faith is believing that God will do what He said in His Word.**
