

God Loves You Just The Way You Are: NO PRETENDING NECESSARY!!! (Psalms 139:14)

Main Thought: we don't have to try and act a certain way so that people will like us. Knowing God made us in a unique and wonderful way helps us realize we can just be ourselves-the amazing person God made us to be.

Lesson Highlights:

It can be fun pretending to be somebody else. We can put on makeup or wear a costume to be someone different.

Activity 1.


