Mark: 2: 3

And they came unto Him, bringing one sick of the palsy, which was borne of four.

Two things marked the life of this cripple; he suffered from a disability that was seen by others. Everybody knew that he was a sick man. I wonder what

Because he was marked by his dependence on other people, everywhere he went, he had to be carried. He was "borne of four." If we are deprived of all that others mean to us in Christian's things, would we be able to stand alone? Are we spiritual cripples with dependence upon others? I pray that we become Healthy Christians pleasing unto God for His glory.
